

REMUS GOLF LEAGUE BY-LAWS

April 26th, 2021

1. The name of the Association shall be known as the Remus Mens League.
2. The Board of Directors shall consist of President, Vice President, and Secretary-Treasurer elected at the annual meeting to be held prior to the opening golf date.
3. The Remus Golf League will golf on Monday evenings with tee times available between 4:00 pm and 5:20 pm. Golfers must tee off between those times.
4. The President (Jack Snyder) shall preside at all meetings. The Vice President (Nedro Carmichael) shall preside in the President's absence. The Secretary-Treasurer (Nick Snyder) shall record the minutes, pay bills, establish schedules, maintain handicaps and team standings, collect dues, etc. Secretary-Treasurer will be paid \$ 21.25 per team, for his services.
5. **The league is to consist of two-man teams.** Memberships shall be limited to twenty six teams. League membership dues are **\$30.00** per season per man. Please pay dues by April 26th, 2021.
6. Handicaps are to be computed at 80% over par for nine holes. The starting handicap is to be the final handicap of the previous year. Thereafter, handicaps will be based on the last four scores.

Example:

Final handicap of last year was 8. Score is 46 which is 10 over par. First score of the new season is 42 which is 6 over par.

Handicap for the second game will be:

$10+10+10+6 = 36$. Divide by 4 = 9. Times 80% = 7.2 or 7.

Fractional handicap of .5 or higher will be rounded to the next whole number. Players without any scores from the previous seasons league games will use score of the first game to establish handicap. Subsequent scores will be used to compute cumulative handicap until four games are completed. The maximum allowable handicap is 18.

- 6a. All players are to use the white tee's, unless they are either at the age of 65 and older, or turning 65 during this year's league. Eligible players, may have the choice of the white or gold tee's. Once the choice of tee is decided, the player cannot change to the other tee throughout the year. If a player decides on using a different color tee, different then the previous year, they must establish a new handicap as if they were new to the league. (NOTE: If switching Tee's from previous year, Secretary must be notified)

7. The handicap of the competing teams is to be based on the difference in the total handicaps.

Example:

Team A has handicaps of 6 and 4 for a total of 10.

Team B has handicaps of 8 and 9 for a total of 17.

Team B will get seven strokes for the nine hole contest.

Strokes will be given according to the course score card hole handicap ranking. When a team only has one player present, that player must compete against the team in the following manner:

- a. The player must double his handicap and subtract 6 to establish his team handicap.
- b. The player's score is then doubled on each hole and matched against the opposing team's total to determine points won.
- c. Nine points shall be awarded in case of team forfeiture.

If either player cannot make league night, effort must be made to contact the other team prior to 4:15 on the night of the scheduled match. One shall call the clubhouse after all efforts are exhausted to contact their opponents. Failure to call either, will end up in a forfeit and nine points will be granted to their opponents that plays on that league night.

Forfeit: When a team is granted a forfeit, they must play their nine holes, to receive nine pts. To qualify for the weekly prize, it must be played on that scheduled league night. Their scores will not count towards their handicap.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: All teams must reserve tee times for (May 31st)
To get league rates, all tee times must be made at 3:00 or after.

- A Points shall be based on total team strokes on each hole including handicap strokes. Team totals for nine holes including team handicaps are as follows:
- B One point for low team total per hole.
- C Three points for low team total for nine holes.
- D Maximum possible team points for nine holes, is twelve.
- E **Note:** In case of ties, points will be halved.
- F We are playing winter rules. The ball may be rolled no more than six inches, no closer to the hole, anywhere. (except lateral hazards, sand traps etc.....)
- G Team standings shall be based on total points won for each half of the season through completion of the position round. The position round teams in each half will be scheduled as one vs. two, three vs. four, five vs. six, etc.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: If two teams tie for position night the team with the lowest handicap will play the team above. Subs will be allowed on position night if the two teams involved, exhaust all efforts to make up the match with regular players.

Subs may also be allowed in the playoffs providing they have a handicap established with our league. This includes players from our League who is not in the Playoffs.

- 8 The league playoffs shall be determined as follows:
 - A The playoffs will be a nine hole match. The top four teams from each half, will qualify for the eight team playoff. If one or more teams qualify both halves, then wildcard teams will qualify to fill up the eight team playoff spots. (It is possible to have up to four wildcard teams in the playoffs) Most total wins for the year, will decide which teams may qualify for the wildcards spots if needed.
 - B After the eight teams have been decided, Total wins, for the year, will determine how each of the eight teams are seeded. The seeded team 1 plays 8, 2 plays 7, 3 plays 6, and 4 plays 5.
 - C The two teams in the championship match, will then compete in an eighteen hole playoff for the league championship. There is a possible 21 points for the championship match. 1 point per hole, 3 points for totals. Green fees are free. The players will be charged for their carts. (Hdcp. Is determined by taking 9 hole hdcp. Posted, Multiplying by 2)
 - D League playoff handicaps shall be determined in the following manner:
If you qualify for the playoffs you will use the lowest handicaps that your team finished either half with, not necessarily the half you qualified in. For example:

	Handicap First Half	Handicap Second Half	Playoff Handicap
Player 1	8	6	8
Player 2	10	13	10

- E Ties for all playoff positions will be “sudden death” starting on hole decided by the league officials, or a full nine hole match may be played, providing all four players agree.
- F Score cards are to be submitted to the Secretary/Treasurer with points won indicated on the card for each team. The cards should be dated, signed by one member of the team, and turned in to the Secretary-Treasurer prior to Sunday of the scheduled week.
- G Water hazards on holes two, eight, ten, eleven, twelve and thirteen are to be played as lateral hazards. Second ball can be re-teeed or dropped between point of entry and tee no nearer to the hole. **Note:** on hole number eight, ball in water at anytime may be dropped on tee side of the water, in the fairway.
- H All disputes shall be submitted to the Board of Directors and their ruling shall be final!
- I Be sure to leave score card in the box in the Lounge or Bar area, labeled Remus, if not handed directly to the league Secretary.
- J League players with established hndcp. May sub in the finals on our league, providing his team is not in the playoff. Regular subs are allowed in the playoffs providing they have established handicaps as well.
- E Matching cards is not recommended. However, if all means have been exhausted to play the actual match, matching cards is allowed. Please make sure you and your opponent play the same side when matching cards. One player team cannot match cards! Forfeit will be the result.

League Payoff!!

- A \$10.00 will be given weekly for proximity, (closest to the pin, best poker hand, etc.). To qualify for the \$10.00 weekly prize, you must play on league night unless the weather cancelled league night. Then the following week 2 proximities will be given. Subs cannot win our weekly proximities.
- B The top four teams of each half will be paid the following week. The teams which qualify first will be awarded \$25.00 each. The teams which qualify second will be awarded \$20.00 each. Teams qualifying 3rd will be awarded \$15.00 each. Teams qualifying fourth will be awarded \$10.00 each. No money is awarded for teams who qualify for the playoff, in a wildcard position.
- C In the championship match, the champions will be awarded \$50.00 each. The runner-ups will be paid \$30.00 each.
